Week 3 is the Disco:

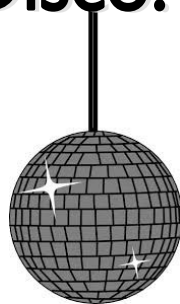
The Preschool disco on **Wednesday 26th October** from **5.30pm - 7pm** in the first Preschool classroom.
