
ACT Public Preschool - Water Safety Procedures

Overview

Activities, excursions and incursions involving water carry an increased risk which must be considered prior to implementation. Certain experiences involving water require the development of a risk assessment. The following flow chart has been developed to support assessment of risks.



Guidelines for effective supervision of water play

Educate children surrounding the risks associated with water and identify strategies to remain safe

Ensure water containers are not filled to a dangerous depth

Ensure educator vigilance by maintaining proximity and direct line of sight during all water play experiences
