

Children's Education & Care Assurance

Children's Education & Care Assurance (CECA) - a section of the ACT Education Directorate – is the ACT Regulatory Authority administering the legislation covering approved education and care services and licensed childcare services in the ACT.

The role of CECA includes:

- Providing information about education and care in the ACT to families, services and the community;
- Issuing approvals for providers, services, waivers, certified supervisors and licenses;
- Monitoring compliance with the legislation including conducting announced and unannounced audits;
- Quality assessment and rating of education and care services in accordance with the National Quality Framework; and
- Investigating complaints relating to compliance with the relevant education and care law.

CECA is staffed by professionals with experience and qualifications in either or both Children's Education and Care and/or Government Investigations.
